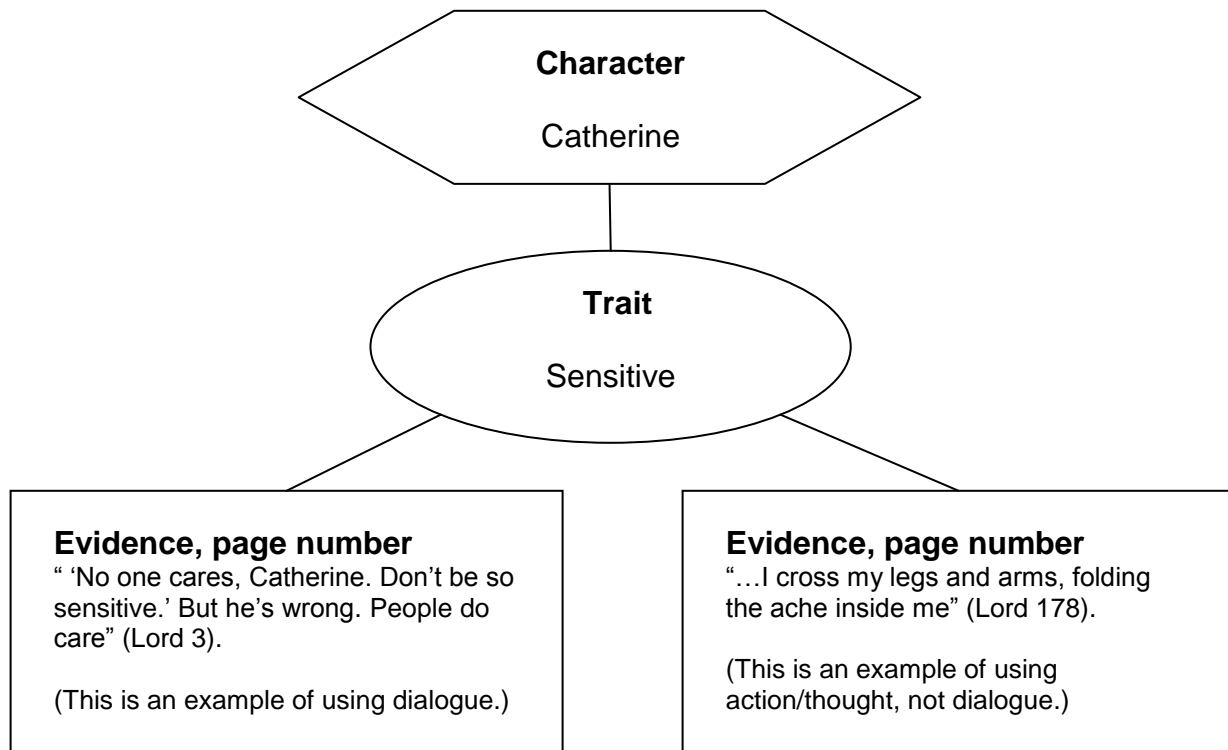

2. Decide which three personality traits best describe the character. Write these traits in the ovals labeled "Traits."
 - Personality traits describe how a character feels, behaves, or acts.
 - Examples of some personality traits are jealous, brave, scared, spoiled, angry, humorous, impatient, generous, mature, loving, selfish, or defiant.
3. In the boxes labeled "Evidence," cite evidence directly from the text using the author's words with page numbers. This evidence should support the trait.
 - The author's words are any lines from the book. They could be something that a character says, does, or thinks.
