<b>WPS COVID Protocols (eff. 3/7/22)</b>	
<b>Mask wearing is optional for all staff &amp; students in Warwick School Buildings, effective March 7, 2022 except as noted below</b>	
<b><u>I have symptoms</u></b>	<b><u>I am COVID Positive</u></b>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Stay home</u></b></p> <p>Test required: home test acceptable however a Rapid &amp; PCR is recommended in order to qualify for the 90 day immunity. *<a href="#">Complete the COVID Reporting Form</a> Isolate until test results are received. May return with a negative PCR and symptoms have improved. If you do not take a test, a 5 day quarantine is required. Recommend contacting your physician if symptoms have not resolved.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Stay home</u></b></p> <p>Isolate for 5 days <a href="#">*Complete the COVID Reporting Form</a> Return to school on day 6 if your symptoms have resolved or have improved (not excreting respiratory secretions) and have been fever-free for 24 hours without medication. Continue to wear a well fitting mask for 5 more days.</p>
<b><u>I am a School Close Contact</u></b> <b><u>(Monitor to Stay Protocols apply see details on pg. 3)</u></b>	
<b><u>Asymptomatic</u></b>	<b><u>Symptomatic</u></b>
<p><b>Vaccinated:</b> Stay in school. Monitor for symptoms. CDC recommends wearing a well fitting mask.</p> <p><b>Unvaccinated:</b> Stay in school. Monitor for symptoms. CDC recommends wearing a well fitting mask.</p> <p>If you are coming to school, you are attesting that you are symptom free.</p>	<p><b>Vaccinated or Unvaccinated:</b> <b><u>Stay Home</u></b></p> <p>Test required: home test acceptable however a Rapid &amp; PCR is recommended in order to qualify for the 90 day immunity. *<a href="#">Complete the COVID Reporting Form</a> Isolate until test results are received. May return with a negative PCR and symptoms have improved. Recommend contacting your physician if symptoms have not resolved.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">If positive, see above.</p>
<b><u>I am a Household Close Contact</u></b>	
<b><u>Vaccinated</u></b>	<b><u>Unvaccinated</u></b>
<p>Stay in school and monitor for symptoms. If symptoms develop, Test required: home test acceptable however a Rapid &amp; PCR is recommended in order to qualify for the 90 day immunity.</p>	<p>Quarantine for 5 days AFTER positive family member finishes their isolation *<a href="#">Complete the COVID Reporting Form</a> Positive person's 5 days + Close contact's 5 days = 10 days</p>

<p>*<a href="#">Complete the COVID Reporting Form</a>          Isolate until test results are received.          May return with a negative PCR and symptoms have improved. Recommend contacting your physician if symptoms have not resolved.</p>	<p>Quarantine may be longer depending on how long symptoms last for positive person.          Test and isolate if symptoms develop.          Wear a mask when returning to school for an additional 5 day to qualify for monitor to stay</p>
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### Quarantine Exemption if Positive for COVID-19 within 90 Days

	Exemptions and Guidance
<b>Quarantine for close contacts</b>	Exempt. Monitor for symptoms for <b>10</b> days after exposure.
<b>Quarantine recommendations for travel (domestic or international)</b>	Exempt. Monitor for symptoms for <b>10</b> days after exposure/travel.
<b>Asymptomatic screening</b>	Not recommended within 90 days of infection
<b>Eligible populations</b>	All individuals
