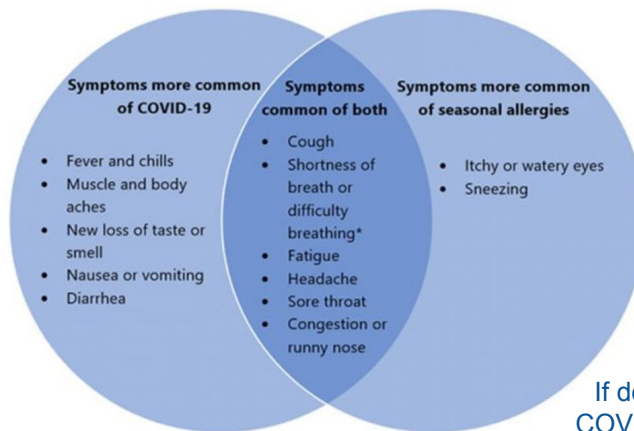
Since we are now in moderate to high transmission, we are **strongly recommending wearing a mask at this time**. However, this is at your discretion. As always, if you are sick you cannot come to school. Stay home and schedule a pcr test.

Any **ONE** major symptom:  
PROBABLE

- Cough (new)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell

Any **TWO** minor symptoms:  
PROBABLE

- Fever or Chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Headaches
- Sore throat
- Fatigue
- Congestion or runny nose (new)
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea



## Travel?

### Domestic or International Vaccinated or Unvaccinated

Upon return, monitor for symptoms for 10 days. If symptomatic, stay home and schedule a pcr test.

## COVID FAQ's

### My child suffers from allergies...

If deemed COVID symptomatic must eliminate COVID as a possibility. If child has allergies make sure a note from PCP is on file with school.

**My child is symptomatic, but tested negative with a Home Test....you will need to confirm with a pcr in order to return to school. If a pcr is not obtained they will remain out of school for 5 days and return wearing a mask for an additional 5 days.**

### My child tested positive less than 90 days ago but is symptomatic...

90 days immunity is NOT a guarantee. RIDOH is reporting rates of reinfection with this new variant. If child is symptomatic he/she will be required to eliminate COVID as a possibility.
